Premise

Transhumance is a phenomenon with a transnational relevance and significance for the understanding and respect of common European values.

Transhumant pastoralism has been a main fundative element of European culture, widespread from the Black Sea to the Atlantic Ocean and from the Mediterranean Sea to the Baltic Sea.

It has originated an extraordinary ethnographic legacy and cultural heritage, which must be preserved (*2003 Unesco Convention For the Safeguarding of the Intangible Cultural Heritage*).

Core elements of this cultural patrimony are the trails, the *grazing landscape*, the livestock, and the herders.

The trails are the basic patterns of the tangible heritage of artifacts, sanctuaries, corrals, craftsmanship, tools and whatever was linked with everyday life and livestock management, as well as the intangible heritage of skills, music, arts, poetry and myth.

The *grazing landscape* is the cultural landscape of pastures and meadows shaped over millennia by the constant interaction between man and nature.

Herders and their flocks are the custodians of this legacy.

Herders are the “human” patrimony; the living heritage.

It is necessary that the Institutions, Bodies, Public Administrations, Associations, and any other Entity who intend to associate or go into partnership with the *International Association Transhumance Trails and Rural Roads* (Acronym: TT&RR), adhere to the cultural assumptions here outlined, share the spirit of this initiative and the goal of bringing people closer together and promote the awareness of the common European cultural roots.

Targets and goals

The International Association TT&RR:

- is a cultural, educational and tourism cooperation initiative;
- fosters the safeguard of the European cultural heritage;
- promotes the intercultural dialogue and the awareness of the common European heritage;
- identifies transhumant pastoralism and traditional grazing as the connecting elements of the cultural roots of the European countries;
- proposes a transdisciplinary approach to the study of the relationships between the transhumance itineraries and the ancient roads;

- identifies in the trails of transhumance the network of connections of proto-historical origin, which have been the vehicle for the enhancement of commercial and cultural exchanges;
- promotes the development of itineraries based on historic transhumance routes;
- aims to link in a common net as many trails of transhumance as possible across Europe, including as many as possible trails of different ranges and degrees of definition.

Certification as Cultural Route of the CoE

The International Association TT&RR has applied for certification as “Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe” in the framework of the 2022-2023 certification for a European Network of *Transhumance Trails and Rural Routes*.

By means of the certification, the International Association TT&RR aims to foster a slow, sustainable, creative tourism, aware of the *Genius Loci*. In this meaning tourism can become a tool of enhancement and promotion for the marginal and internal areas.

The International Association TT&RR is committed to promote awareness and sustainable development, involving all the local stakeholders, local administrations, public institutions, local grassroot associations, as well as local communities, civil society and young people, who will be the future operators, and the custodians of the cultural heritage.

In case of achievement of the certification, each member of the International Association TT&RR will gain the use of the logos of Council of Europe and Cultural Route.

Membership

- agree with its aims, objectives, and tasks pursued with the application for certification as Cultural Route;
- share the principles recalled in the Premise, which form an integral part of this declaration.
